Dear Valued Neighbor and Client,

The District last implemented a modest across the board water rate increase in November 2013, which was intended not only to cover a budget shortfall at the time but also to encourage water conservation. As many of you are aware, the District is allotted 500,000 gallons/day per its contract with the City of Seabrook. Over the last few years on many of the months of the year, particularly during the summer months, usage has been exceeding this amount much more regularly than in the past. Accordingly, the District has added additional tiers to its schedule of water rates to further encourage water conservation. Please note that water rates for usage up to and including 50,000 gallons in one month have proved successful in encouraging conservation and remain unchanged. The complete water rate schedule is listed on the reverse of this page for your edification.

The District also implemented a flat \$5.00 increase in its sewer fee from \$20.00 to \$25.00, which will help fund ongoing renovation, maintenance, and repair of sewer system infrastructure.

The District took these actions at its regular board meeting on April 12, 2019, after much deliberation at prior meetings.

The modified rate schedule and new sewer fee will go into effect on June 1, 2019.

Lastly, please note that even with these changes our water, sewer, and tax rates remain among the lowest in Harris County among similar entities and service providers.

On behalf of the Board of Directors and the entire District staff, I would like to thank you for your understanding and continued support.
