TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

Be it remembered that on this day, with notice to Defendant Seagate Owners Association, Inc. ("Seagate"), came on for consideration the Application for Temporary Restraining Order (the "Application") contained in Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 50's (the "District") verified Original Petition and Application for Injunctive Relief (the "Petition"). Having considered the Application, and it clearly appearing from the facts set forth in the Petition that imminent and irreparable injury, loss, and damage will result to the District unless the Application is granted, the District further having no adequate remedy at law, in that the blockage of the storm-sewer outfall from TxDOT's 4x6' box culvert into Clear Lake (i) prevents the proper and adequate operation of the District's drainage facilities and (ii) exposes the District and its residents, businesses, and facilities to the constant threat of additional flooding, the Court is of the opinion the Application should be granted.


Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that:

1. The District's Application, as set forth in the Petition, is GRANTED.
2. Seagate, its officers, agents, servants, employees, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them are hereby enjoined from (i) continuing the blockage of the storm-sewer outfall from TxDOT's 4x6' box culvert into Clear Lake and (ii) conducting further activities that prevent or interfere with the operation of the District's drainage system.
